



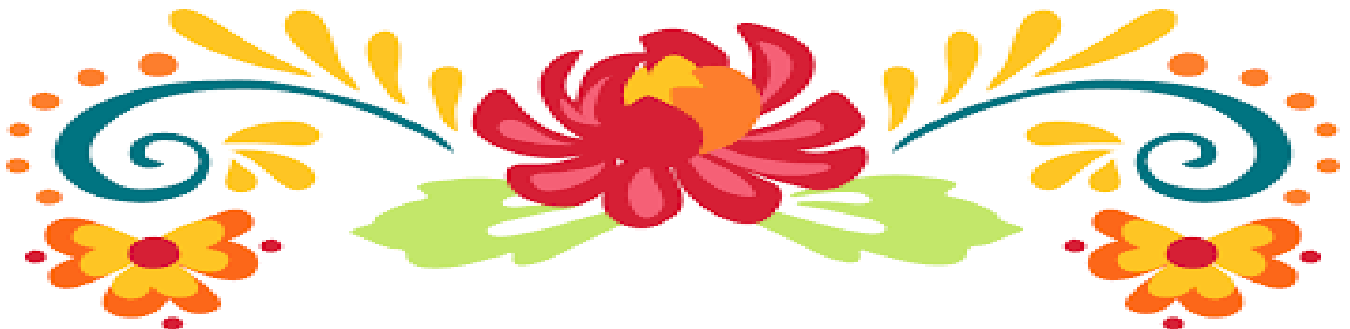
## TO IES SPANISH PROGRAM
